**THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE:** *Romans 12v3-21*

**THIS WEEK'S BIG IDEA:** When caught up in conflict, we tend to view people as difficult, forgetting that – more often than not – the same thing could be said about us.

**Reflect:** *Who is the person in your life that is most difficult to love and why?*

**Reflect:** *Would you describe yourself as a particular proud person or a humble person, and how do you think others would describe you?*

**Reflect:** *When you're engaged in a conflict with someone, do you often feel as though you are right and they are wrong? How could you step back to discern your role in the conflict?*

**Reflect:** *In Matthew 18, Jesus says that if we can't resolve a conflict with someone, we should reengage them from a different perspective, in his case, a pagan or tax collector. How can we reengage someone with whom we are engaged in conflict in a different way and treat them like Jesus treated tax collectors and sinners?*

**Reflect:** *What is one way that you can practically respond to the message this week?*

**Rest & Reflect:** *Days 6 & 7 are days of rest and reflection. Use these days to dig a bit deeper if you feel inspired.*
