THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE: *Revelation, chapters 20-22*

THIS WEEK'S BIG IDEA: Revelation is a passionate invitation to join in the consummation of the reconciliation of all things made possible by and through the blood of the Lamb who was slain.

Reflect: How has your reading through Revelation been going this week? Where have you been struggling?

Reflect: We tend to think of “going to heaven” when we die, but Revelation paints a different picture. How is it different from how we traditionally talk about it? Scholar NT Wright has said that in Revelation 21 we get a glimpse of what our life will be after our “life after life after death,” in other words, in our eternally resurrected life lived with God in the New Jerusalem.

Reflect: What emotions stir in you when you read the description of our destiny as followers of Jesus in Rev. 21v1-7?

Reflect: Judgment is a theme of these chapters. How does the idea that we will be judged, even those of us who are in Christ, for what we did with the life God gave us?

Reflect: Revelation ends with an invitation to long for Christ's return: “Amen. Come, Lord Jesus.” How are you longing for Christ to return?

Rest & Reflect: Days 6 & 7 are days of rest and reflection. Use these days to dig a bit deeper if you feel inspired.
