**THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE:** *Nahum 1v12-15, NIV*

**THIS WEEK'S BIG IDEA:** *God is patient to a point, but his people can always trust in his promises.*

**Reflect:** How do you react when you read some of the more difficult passages of the Bible?

**Reflect:** God's anger in the Scriptures is always calculated and measured, seeking to bring about justice, deliverance, and reconciliation. Where do you see this in some of the difficult books or verses that you've read before?

**Reflect:** Nahum and 2 Peter say that God is "patient." How have you personally experienced the patience of God or witnessed it in someone else's life?

**Reflect:** Nahum is writing about Nineveh 152 years after Jonah's experience. Do you think God was fair in judging Nineveh? Do you think God should have given them more time? Why, or why not?

**Reflect:** How do you take comfort in the promise that God will one day rid the world of pain, evil, and injustice and put the world to right?

**Rest & Reflect:** Days 6 & 7 are days of rest and reflection. Use these days to dig a bit deeper if you feel inspired.
