THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE: *Ephesians 3v1-21, NIV*

THIS WEEK'S BIG IDEA The Church is the means through which God reveals to the world the mystery of what God has done in Christ.

Reflect: Paul calls himself a “*prisoner of Christ Jesus*” and a “*servant of the Gospel.*” What do you think he means by that? Would you categorize your life in those words? Why, or why not?

Reflect: Bringing together Jews and Gentiles into one family would have been a rather contentious proposition in Paul’s day. What would be a modern day comparison? Who could you not imagine being part of Grace Church and how might we open ourselves to them?

Reflect: What are some of the ways that you attempt to grasp the width, depth, and breadth of God’s love for you in your life?

Reflect: Paul says that he longs for his Ephesian friends to be “rooted and established” in Christ. In the Greek, these are perfect passive participles, meaning that this is something God has already done for us. How has God done this for you?

Reflect: What’s one practical thing you can do to respond to this week’s message?

Rest & Reflect: Days 6 & 7 are days of rest and reflection. Use these days to dig a bit deeper if you feel inspired.
